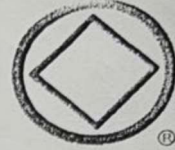

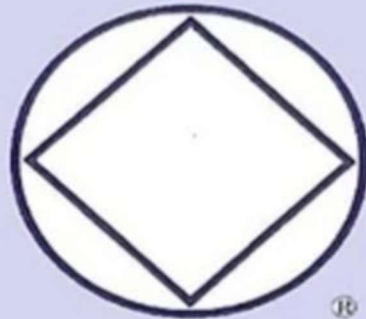

FAQs

1. **Why use this?** Paying \$15/mo for 1-2 meetings a week or \$65/mo for a 500 person room could waste a lot of NA funds. Also, No technical setup for Zoom. All settings are configured for you & you can use things not available on a Pro account.
2. **Why is ENYR offering this?** After much debate, an NA Shared Service helps all of us. It reduces costs while keeping things simple for our members & groups. We are one fellowship so why should we keep such a valuable tool to our region alone?
3. **Can we keep our meeting ID or get it back if we leave VGSK?** Yes, Meeting IDs can be moved around and this has been done many times over the last 3 years.
4. **How much does it cost?** A once a week 2-3hr slot is currently \$3/mo or an Off-Peak Daily meeting \$9/Month and may go down if more share this service. A full License is \$21/month.
5. **How long will VGSK be available?** Hopefully indefinitely, if it is supported by our members and groups. As long as the desire for Virtual Meetings continues so should the Shared Service. 3+ years so far.

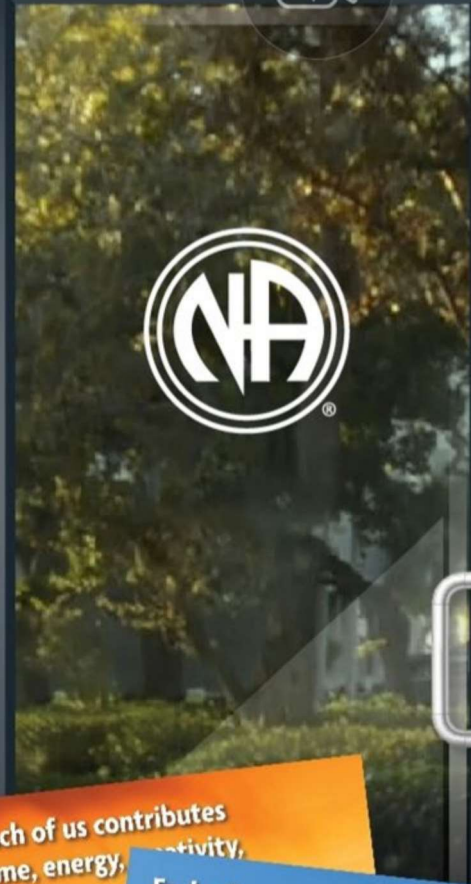
1. **Contact the Webmaster for ENYR.** Use the following web form to reach out with questions and availability of the VGSK. <https://NANewYork.org/vgsk>
2. **Have all your relevant information available.** A Primary Contact Person, their Phone & email, Time w/Zone of the needed meeting slot, Current Zoom ID & Special Needs if any.
3. **Conscience to make the move.** Talk to the trusted servants involved and schedule a time to move.
4. **Move your existing ID.** With PMID's (10-Digits) Switching is really quick BUT space is VERY Limited. 9 or 11 Digit ID moves require the member with Zoom Owner access to be available. Takes 15-20 mins.
5. **Running a Meeting is simple.** After everything is set up & moved all you need to Host the Meeting is the **Host Key**. Everything else stays the same for meeting Hosts & Co-hosts.
6. **Being fully self supporting.** Sending funds to support the service is required outside the region. We ask that you use Venmo, Paypal or CC through our GiveButter donation platform. Recurring amounts can be set to make things easy. Sending more than 1 month at a time is helpful also. This is ONLY for Zoom funding. GiveButter.com/ENYR-VGSK
